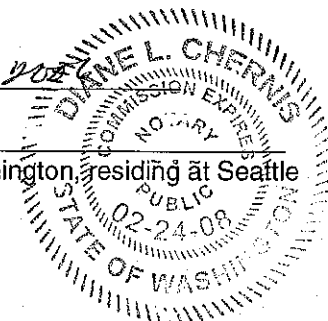

Formation of Regional Fire Protection Service Authority

On November 7, 2006, voters approved the ballot measure to create a Regional Fire Protection Service Authority in the Cities of Auburn, Algona, and Pacific under RCW 52.26. The results of the election were certified on November 28, 2006. A party challenging the procedure or the formation of this voter-approved authority must file the challenge in writing by serving the prosecuting attorney of each county within, or partially within, the Regional Fire Protection Service Authority and the Attorney General within 30 days after final certification of the election (RCW 52.26.070).
