Irrigation Systems

Sections:

13.58.010 Irrigation water—Service charge.

13.58.020 Low-income senior citizen irrigation water charges.

13.58.010 Irrigation water—Service charge. The rates charged residents provided irrigation water from the two City-owned and maintained irrigation systems shall be as follows:

1. The rate charged residents provided water from the Columbia Irrigation District via the City-maintained irrigation water distribution system shall be as follows:

Location	Monthly Rate
Brotherhood	10.25
Brotherhood (school)	250.00
Flat Top	10.25
Luann Estates	11.00

2. The foregoing rates shall be charged for those months in which irrigation water is supplied through the Columbia Irrigation District canal; typically May, June, July, August, September, and October.

3. In addition to the monthly service charge set forth above, there shall be a one-time connection charge of \$10.00 for each connection of $\frac{3}{4}$ " to the irrigation system. In the event that a connection is larger than $\frac{3}{4}$ ", the one-time charge shall be based upon a determination by the Public Works Director of City costs.

4. The irrigation water service charged to the Brotherhood (school) may be billed for the total year on a monthly basis. (Ord. 9-99 §1, 1999; Ord. 40-94 §1, 1994; Ord. 19-93 §1, 1993).

13.58.020 Low-income senior citizen irrigation water charges. An irrigation water account for single point delivery in the name of a low-income senior citizen shall be charged at a rate which is 70% of the rate established in Section 13.58.010 for homes on the same irrigation system. These rates shall be charged for those months in which irrigation water is supplied. A reduced irrigation water service charge pursuant to this section shall be limited to one per eligible individual and one per property served. (Ord. 40-94 §1, 1994; Ord. 19-93 §1, 1993).
