ORDINANCE NO. 812

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 541 OF THE CITY OF CASHMERE AND RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF NOISE WITHIN THE CITY OF CASHMERE.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Cashmere to regulate noise within the City of Cashmere; and,

WHEREAS, there are discernable standards by which such noise may be regulated; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable for citizens to participate in certain ceremonial noise making activities;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cashmere,

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 541 of the City of Cashmere and Chapter 9.90.030 of the Cashmere Municipal Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

It is unlawful to fire or discharge any gun, cannon, pistol, revolver or rifle containing bullets or missiles that are discharged from said gun, cannon, pistol, revolver or rifle within the city limits of the City of Cashmere.

Section 2. All adult persons, organizations or entities who engage in any noise making activity, including but not limited to ceremonial rifle or weapon firing, making of artificial noise in connection with an event or activity shall first obtain a nonfee permit from the City of Cashmere. The application shall set forth the entity responsible for the noise, the nature of the noise, the time and place of the creation of said noise and the anticipated duration of said noise. Failure to obtain a permit and upon a complaint as to the offensiveness of said noise, the perpetrator shall be presumed to have violated this ordinance.

Section 3. All noise referred to hereinabove shall be made within the parameters established by the Washington Administrative Code as now enacted or as hereinafter amended.

Section 4. Violations of this ordinance shall be punishable by a penalty of up to \$250 per offense.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, its invalidity shall not affect any other provisions of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision, and for this purpose the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect when it shall have been passed by the City Council of the City of Cashmere, signed by the Mayor and attested to by the City Clerk/Treasurer and after its publication in the Cashmere Valley Record, the official newspaper of said City, and after the necessary period has elapsed as provided by law.
