

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, GRANTING A LICENSE TO THE POULSBO FARMERS MARKET TO CONDUCT THE MARKET ON PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF POULSBO FROM JULY THROUGH OCTOBER FOR THE YEAR 2004 ONLY, AS MAY BE CONDITIONED BY RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, THE City Council of the City of Poulsbo, Washington makes the following findings of fact:

1. Tourism within the City of Poulsbo stimulates business activity and can result in substantial revenue to businesses and residents of the City of Poulsbo;
2. Studies have shown there are many tourism advantages to farmers markets and the Poulsbo Farmers Market has the potential of becoming the largest open market in the county;
3. Tourism and the revenue it generates often stimulate an increased community pride while at the same time providing the fiscal means to assist in the maintaining of the community in a manner in which it can be proud;
4. The large number of persons and temporary businesses drawn to the City during farmers markets can place a strain upon the ability of the City to provide the community services necessary to ensure the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and
5. Granting license to the Poulsbo Farmers Market upon such conditions as the City Council, by resolution, may impose ensures the probability of placing minimal strain upon the community services provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Poulsbo Farmers Market will be of benefit to businesses and city residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to support the Farmers Market concept in Poulsbo by acknowledging it as a special event for the year 2004 only, during which time the impacts to the city can be measured for proper regulation of possible ongoing Farmers Market events;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Poulsbo Farmers Market, a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Washington, shall be granted license to conduct business on private property in the City of Poulsbo with various vendors from July through October in 2004, after which time Council shall determine whether to grant an extended license to the event; and

Section 2. Council may, upon adoption of a resolution, impose whatever conditions they consider appropriate to ensure minimal strain upon city services.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.
