

RESOLUTION NO. 1094 (2000)  
CITY OF BOTHELL, WASHINGTON

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOTHELL,  
WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING POLICES AND PROCEDURES RELATING  
TO THE NAMING OF PUBLIC PARKS AND PARKS AND RECREATION  
FACILITIES.

Whereas, the City Council believes that the designation of names for parks and parks and recreation facilities should be approached with deliberation; and

Whereas the City Council further believes that the setting forth by resolution of policies and procedures relating to the naming of public parks and parks and recreation facilities is in the public interest; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOTHELL,  
WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: It is the policy of the City of Bothell to choose names for parks and parks and recreation facilities based upon the following criteria in no particular priority order:

1. Neighborhood or geographical identification (e.g., Royal Oaks Park);
2. A natural or geological feature (e.g., North Creek Sportsfields);
3. Historical or cultural significance (e.g. Park at Bothell Landing);
4. An historical figure (e.g. William Penn Park); or an individual (living or deceased) who has made a significant land, monetary or civic contribution to the park system.


5. As required by purchase agreement.

Section 2: The City Council shall designate the names of and parks and recreation facilities. Unless the park name is designated in a purchase agreement or an accepted gift of park property, the City Council should make its selection after receiving a recommendation from the Bothell Parks and Recreation Board, which shall be based upon public input from individuals and organizations.


Section 3: Following selection of a park or parks and recreation facility name by the City Council, the Parks and Recreation Department shall identify the specific park or facility by appropriate signing specifying the name.
