

ORDINANCE NO. 2058

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2054 ANNEXING PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE LDS CHURCH PROPERTY, TO THE CITY OF MOSES LAKE, WASHINGTON, AND INCORPORATING THE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MOSES LAKE, AND WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE ASSUMPTION OF EXISTING INDEBTEDNESS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOSES LAKE, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2054 adopted on March 12, 2002 is amended as follows:

The following described real estate, as shown on the attached map marked Exhibit A which by this reference is incorporated within this ordinance, situated in Grant County contiguous to the City of Moses Lake is hereby annexed to and incorporated in the City of Moses Lake:

LDS Church Second Addition Short Plat AFN 1072112 less the right-of-way of Nelson Road

Section 2. The property shall be zoned R-1, Single Family Residential.

Section 3. All property within the territory annexed shall hereinafter be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as other property within the city to pay for any outstanding indebtedness of the City of Moses Lake contracted prior to or existing at the date of annexation. No property herein annexed shall be released from any outstanding indebtedness levied against it prior to said annexation.

Section 4. That a copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, Washington.

Section 5. The City Council declares that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall take effect immediately as provided by law upon one reading if 2/3 of the entire City Council present vote in favor of passage.
