

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

WHEREAS, within their respective jurisdictions, the Everett School District No. 2, the City of Mill Creek, and the County of Snohomish have responsibility and authority derived from the laws of the State of Washington to provide a variety of services, including, but not limited to, education, recreation, maintenance, and leisure time services; and

WHEREAS, the District, the City, and the County recognize that many of the services provided by each jurisdiction have extra-jurisdictional impacts; and

WHEREAS, each of the three governmental units share the opinion that intergovernmental cooperation is an effective way under existing law to deal with impacts and opportunities that extend across jurisdictional boundaries; and

WHEREAS, a cooperative effort between these three governmental agencies can eliminate an unnecessary duplication of services and can allow tax revenues to be more effectively used to meet the educational, recreational, and leisure time needs of the region; and

WHEREAS, the legislative bodies of these three governmental agencies desire to express and act on their common desire to begin discussions to promote the integration, cooperation, and efficiency of their respective service delivery systems; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that at the conclusion of these discussions, the entities will memorialize their agreements and understandings through an interlocal agreement, pursuant to Section 39.34 of the Revised Code of Washington;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Everett School District No. 2, the City of Mill Creek, and the County of Snohomish, Washington mutually agree as follows:


Within thirty (30) days of the date of the execution of this memorandum of understanding, the parties shall commence negotiations on an interlocal agreement, to be executed as soon as possible, which addresses:


- 1) Development of active and passive recreation areas, public property and public facilities
- 2) Maintenance of active and passive recreation areas, public property and public facilities

- 3) Operation, access, and scheduling of public property and facilities
- 4) Shared financial commitments concerning development, maintenance and operation of public property and public facilities
- 5) Enhancing communications between local governments and its citizens
- 6) Any other subjects, topics, or items that promote the integration, cooperation, efficiency, and/or effectiveness of the entities' service delivery systems


