

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN CITY OF RICHLAND AND THE CHINOOK CYCLING CLUB

THIS MEMORANDUM, entered into this 11TH day of JANUARY, 2007 by and between the City of Richland, 505 Swift Avenue, Richland, Washington, (hereinafter called the "City"), and the Chinook Cycling Club (hereinafter called the Club).

Whereas, the City of Richland leases from the Corps of Engineers the area known as the Chamna Natural Preserve under lease number W912EF-1-04-14, and

Whereas the City of Richland's Parks and Recreation Department promotes activities that encourage recreation and healthy living, and

Whereas, the Chinook Cycling Club promotes active and healthy life styles through outdoor recreation, and

Whereas the Club wishes to have installed a portable toilet at the Chamna Natural Preserve for the use of their members and other Chamna users,

Now, therefore, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Chinook Cycling Club shall provide a portable toilet at the Chamna Natural Preserve for the use of all Chamna visitors. The Club shall enter into a contract with a portable toilet provider for the installation, removal and maintenance of the toilet. The toilet shall be located per the attached drawing. The Club shall be responsible for all financial costs associated with the installation, removal and maintenance of the toilet. At the end of the agreement the portable toilet and concrete slab shall be removed by the Chinook Cycling Club.



3. If the City notifies the Club of a violation of this agreement and there is a failure to correct a situation, this agreement can be canceled by the City Manager by giving a cancellation notice to the above named party.
4. This Agreement shall be for valid to December 31, 2008.


