AMENDING RESOLUTION #356 OF THE TOWN OF WILBUR SETTING THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE WILBUR AMBULANCE SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Town of Wilbur Council has adopted the Wilbur Municipal Code Title 13, Chapter 13.20, Ordinance #486 authorizing the council to adopt the Wilbur Ambulance Service fees by Resolution and;

WHEREAS, this action allows for less expense and difficulty in approving changes to the fee schedule for the Wilbur Ambulance and;

WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Wilbur wishes to increase those Ambulance supplies which have increased in price for the Town of Wilbur,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WILBUR DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

FEE SCHEDULE: The following fees shall be charged by the Town of Wilbur and credited to the appropriate fund:

AMBULANCE FEES.

Fees for the ambulance fund shall be as follows:

A. Single Patient--Base Rate.

1. BLS, two hundred ninety-seven dollars.
2. BLS-emergency, four hundred fifty-seven dollars.
3. ALS, three hundred fifty-seven dollars.
4. ALS-emergency, five hundred sixty-five dollars.

B. Multiple patients: Person in life-threatening situation receives full charge.

Additional patients are rated as follows:

1. Per patient, seventy-five dollars.

C. Mileage Per Mile (with patient loaded).

1. Miles one through fifty, nine dollars and fifty cents.
2. Miles fifty-one and over, eight dollars.

3. Additional patients, two dollars.
- D. Auto Pulse, ~~one hundred~~ one hundred fifty dollars.
- E. Defibrillator Shock Pads, one hundred dollars.
- F. Other Services (included in base rate--for information only).
 1. Oxygen, fifteen dollars.
 2. Resuscitator bag with oral airway, twenty-five dollars.
 3. Suction, ~~seven~~ fifteen dollars.
 4. Combi tube airway, sixty-five dollars.
 5. Oral airway, ~~four~~ six dollars.
 6. OB kit, twenty dollars.
 7. Burn sheet, fifteen dollars.
 8. Hot/cold pack, four dollars.
 9. Trauma dressing, five dollars.
 10. Ace bandage, ~~two~~ four dollars.
 11. Vacuum splint, twenty-five dollars.
 12. Cervical collar, twenty dollars.
 13. Bandages, five dollars.
 14. IV therapy, ~~thirty~~ thirty-five dollars.
 15. Saline lock, ten dollars.
 16. Disposable blanket, ~~seven dollars and fifty cents~~ nine dollars.
 17. Glucose test kit, ten dollars.
 18. Oral glucose, ten dollars.
 19. Charcoal--poison kit, ~~fifteen~~ thirty-one dollars.
 20. Eppie pen, ~~seventy-five~~ seventy-eight dollars.
 21. Wound kit, ~~four~~ ten dollars.
 22. Defibrillator: ~~with shock pads, fifty dollars; with~~ monitor pads, ten dollars.
 23. Drugs (per dose):
 - Albuterol, ~~four~~ five dollars.
 - Nitrostat, ~~one~~ three dollars.
 - Narcan, ~~twenty~~ twenty-five dollars.
 - D-50 (adult), ~~five~~ six dollars.
 - D-50 (pediatric), twelve dollars.
 - Baby aspirin, ~~fifty cents~~ three dollars.
 - Dextrose, seven dollars.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
