Recreation Scholarship Guidelines

1. The City of Lakewood and Kidz Love Soccer recognize that individuals and families may need financial assistance in order to participate in recreation programs.
2. To be eligible for a recreation scholarship, individuals must reside in the city limits. Please bring your utility bill with your address at the time of application for purposes of verification of address.
3. To qualify, the applicant must show proof one of the following:
 - i. Qualification for free/reduced lunch through the Clover Park School District.
 - ii. 2004 IRS tax return with total household income.
4. If your financial status has recently changed and your latest tax return does not reflect your household income, you may bring copies of latest employment earnings; for example an Unemployment verification and eligibility letter.
5. All applicants must be completed in person, by applicant, at the Lakewood Parks and Recreation Department office. All information will be kept confidential.
6. Scholarships will be granted to those who qualify on a first come, first served basis while funding is available.
