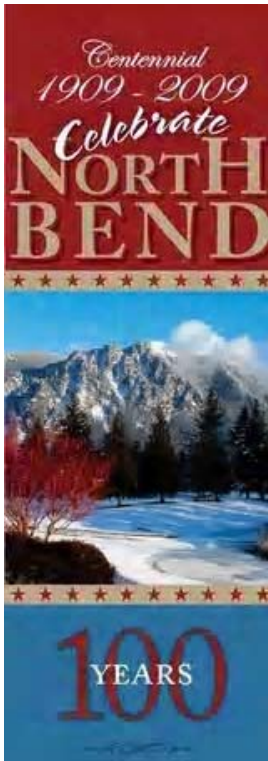

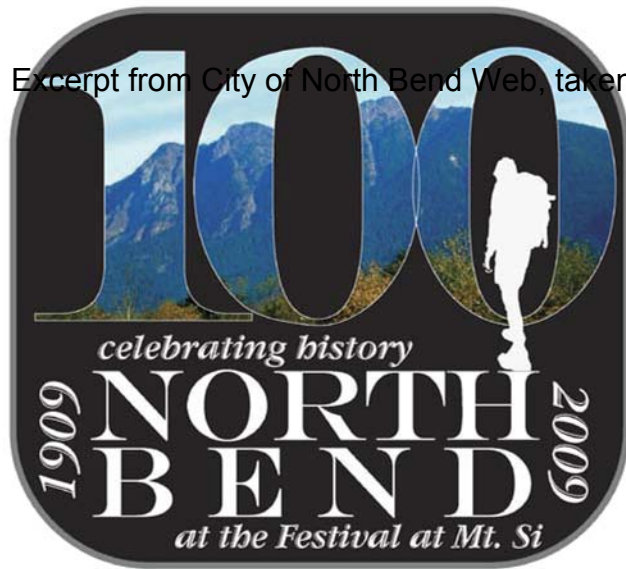

THE NORTH BEND CENTENNIAL MURALS - "THE ARTS IN NORTH BEND.....ARE ALIVE AND GROWING"

North Bend, WA – A local artist, local businesses, a building owner and the City of North Bend have come together to make possible the "The North Bend Centennial Murals". The murals are comprised of five panels, totaling 50 feet in length. Artist, Dick Burhans generously donated his time and energy to paint the murals. Each panel depicts a local artist in action; potter Jeff Griswold, cross stitcher Richard Buchmiller, Valley Center Stage stars Gary Schwartz and Tina Brandon, Joyce Littlejohn and Georgia Kramer who appear alongside the artist Dick Burhans as models. The murals will be hung on Bill Glazier's Antique Building located at the corner of North Bend Way and Bendigo.

Accurate Electric donated labor and materials, installing seven new light fixtures and all associated electrical work. The lights will subtly illuminate the murals during evening hours. Claffey's Painting has donated labor and materials to paint the entire building. The City contributed funds for project materials associated with the murals. The generosity of our local businesses made this Centennial Mural project possible and will help bring Downtown North Bend to life just in time for the North Bend Centennial Block Party on June 27th from 4pm -10pm and Festival at Mt. Si, Aug. 7-9th.

Come help celebrate the City of North Bend's 100th year anniversary in 2009 during the Downtown Block Party on June 27th. The Downtown Block Party, presented by Downtown Merchants and the North Bend Festival Committee, is intended to promote Downtown North Bend, its small town character and its businesses while preserving the past, celebrating the present, and embracing the future.

The Block Party would like to invite vendors to participate in the 2009 Downtown Block Party.

Where: The Downtown Block Party is located in the heart of North Bend on North Bend Way between Bendigo Blvd and Ballarat. The Block Party is scheduled for June 27th, from 4 pm to 10 pm.

Booths: The Block Party provides booth space only. All booths must be open and operational from 4 pm to 10 pm on Saturday June 27th. North Bend Way will be closed for the event from 12:00 pm to 12:00 midnight. Vendors will be allowed to set up between 12:00 pm and 4pm and clean up from 10 pm – Midnight.

Security: The Block Party will be staffed by King County Sheriffs.

Liability Insurance: Vendors will be required to provide a copy of their liability insurance.

INFORMATION CONTINUED ON BACK

The Application Form accompanying this letter is self-explanatory. All applications must include photo(s) of booth & merchandise and a written inventory of items to be displayed, sold or given away for free. (See application for details.) Please write vendor's name on the back of all photos. Vendor's wishing photos returned must provide a self addressed, stamped envelope with correct postage.

The Festival Committee reserves the right to disqualify a vendor whose merchandise is inappropriate for the event or if the content, form, and/or quality of the merchandise is not consistent with the photos/inventory provided with the application. Prohibited items include but are not limited to: silly string, crazy foam, colored hair sprays, bomb bags, bad smelling sprays or merchandise, fake cigarettes, illegal items, or items that make a mess or damage property.

No vendor is guaranteed exclusive rights to sell certain products. All efforts are made, however, to jury and monitor products sold, to maintain a good balance between supply and demand. It is vital that vendors list products to be sold to support the Festival Committee in their efforts to promote this balance.

Payment: Check or money order for full payment, made out to North Bend Festival Committee, must be attached to this application to ensure processing.

Notification: Vendors will be notified by e-mail regarding acceptance. If you do not have an email address, please make a note of that on your application. There are no refunds issued after June 15th, 2009. If an application is denied, all payments and materials will be returned to the applicant.

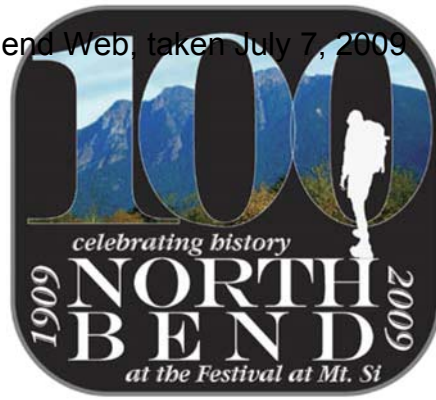
