6.05.010 Authority to adopt animal control regulations.

The town hereby adopts by reference KCC Title 11, Animal Control, attached to the ordinance codified in this chapter as Exhibit A and by this reference fully incorporated herein, as presently constituted or hereinafter amended, as the animal control regulations of the town of Hunts Point, except that all violations of this chapter shall be civil infractions and not criminal misdemeanors. A copy of KCC Title 11 has been filed with the town administrator. [Ord. 405 § 1, 2002]

6.05.020 Adoption of administrative rules.

The town adopts by reference any and all implementing administrative rules now in effect regarding KCC Title 11, Animal Control, that have been adopted either pursuant to Chapter 2.98 KCC, Rules of County Agencies, KCC Title 23, Enforcement, or elsewhere in the King County Code except that, unless the context requires otherwise, any reference to the “County” or to “King County” shall refer to the town of Hunts Point, and any reference to county staff shall refer to the town administrator or his designee. 6.05.030 Powers delegated to King County.

The town hereby specifically delegates the following to King County:

- (1) The power to determine eligibility for licenses issued under the terms of this chapter, subject to the conditions set forth in this chapter and subject to the review power of the King County board of appeals; and
- (2) The power to enforce the terms of this chapter, including the power to deny, suspend or revoke licenses issued in accordance with
