

ORDINANCE NO. 426

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING.

WHEREAS, the Town purchased a site in 1957 for accommodations to the residents of Almira to haul yard waste to a central location; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology is placing restrictions upon the Town to eliminate any residential burning privileges in order for the Town to obtain a burn permit at the central yard waste site.

NOWHEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Almira do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 401 dated 3-10-98 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Residential burning is prohibited all year around.

Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. The ordinance is hereby approved and the Town Clerk is directed to publish the same in the Town's official newspaper pursuant to RCW 35.27.300.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval and five days after its publication.
