

ORDINANCE NO. 433

AN ORDINANCE REPLACING ORDINANCE NO. 236 RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION OF DOGS, PROHIBITING DOGS TO RUN AT LARGE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING THE ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF ALMIRA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any owner or keeper of any dog in the Town of Almira to keep the same within the Town limits unless such dog is duly registered with the Town of Almira. Registration of the said dog shall be accomplished by the Town Clerk/Treasurer who, upon payment to the Town, a fee of \$5.25 per calendar year shall issue a registration receipt to the party requesting registration which shall include a description of the dog duly registered, a copy of which shall be retained by the Town. Registration fees are payable by resident dog owners no later than January 31 of each calendar year. The owner of any unlicensed dog shall be fined the sum of \$10.00 in addition to the established fee.

SECTION 2. That it shall be unlawful to permit any dog to run at large in the Town of Almira. The owner of such dog permitted to run at large shall be fined the sum of \$25.00 for the first offense and the sum of \$50.00 for each subsequent offense.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts thereof which are not consistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and affect from and after its passage and publication.
