

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-25

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN ETHICS PROGRAM FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF BAINBRIDGE ISLAND IN ACCORDANCE WITH BIMC CHAPTER 2.07.

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2005, the City Council passed, and on October 27, 2005, the Mayor approved, Ordinance No. 2005-31, which provides that “[t]he City Council shall establish by resolution or ordinance an ethics program for elected officials of the City of Bainbridge Island”; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2006, the Mayor and City Council reviewed the draft “Ethics Program” and requested certain changes; and

WHEREAS, attached is a written Ethics Program that incorporates the changes Council requested at its meeting on March 6, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Bainbridge Island to formally approve and adopt said written Ethics Program; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAINBRIDGE ISLAND, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to BIMC 2.07.010, the attached Ethics Program is hereby approved and adopted as the Ethics Program for elected officials of the City of Bainbridge Island.
