ROAD RESOLUTION NO. 2334

WHEREAS, it is advisable for the County to formally adopt standards for construction on County roads in order to maintain a uniform system of roads and,

WHEREAS, it is becoming increasingly important to provide developers and other individuals with a set of standards by which they are required to construct roads in Lincoln County, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation, Local Programs Division, has adopted design standards in the Local Agency Guidelines for use on State and Federally funded County Road projects, and


WHEREAS, the adopted standards do not coincide exactly with the standards the Board wishes to apply to roads in Lincoln County, and


WHEREAS, the width requirements of the users of roads in Lincoln County may be different than those of other areas, yet similar to other agricultural areas,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Lincoln County Commissioners, that the attached table of Design Standards is hereby adopted, and shall be applied to new construction of all roads under the County's jurisdiction. The same standards shall apply to all new construction performed in developments, at the ADT level of full build-out of the development, per the Lincoln County Subdivision Ordinance Section 12.


