C. Industrial or commercial sewer system customers disposing of other than domestic strength sewage, that is unusual waste or unusual amounts of waste or water as determined by the Public Works Director, or where the industrial or commercial customer does not obtain water from the City's domestic water system, will be subject to individually applied rates as established by the Public Works Director. The Public Works Director, at his discretion, may require the customer to measure its discharge into the City sewer system to assist at arriving at an appropriate rate.

D. Where the use of water by an industrial or commercial customer is such that a majority of the water delivered to the customer does not discharge into the City sewer system due to its evaporation or use in the manufacturing process, such as ice making, canned goods, beverages or similar processes, the customer shall provide proof thereof satisfactory to the Public Works Director as to the amount and composition of the discharge into the City sewer system and the rate to be paid by the customer shall be adjusted accordingly by the Public Works Director.

E. The rate for sewage service and disposal provided to customers whose premises or property is located outside of the City limits shall carry an additional fifty percent surcharge above the rates established by this section. (Ord. 16-03 §1, 2003).

13.26.030 Low-income senior citizen charges.

A. A single family residential sewerage account in the name of a low-income senior citizen shall be charged at a rate which is seventy percent of the rate established for single family residences in Section 13.28.020.

B. A reduced sewerage service charge pursuant to the section shall be limited to one per eligible individual and one for each property served.

C. The application, determination of eligibility and administration of the low-income senior citizen domestic sewer rates shall be in accordance with the provisions of West Richland Municipal Code Section 1.20.010.

D. These rates shall become effective January 1, 1991. (Ord. 16-03 §1, 2003).
