

ORDINANCE NO. 426

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING.

WHEREAS, the Town purchased a site in 1957 for accommodations to the residents of Almira to haul yard waste to a central location; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology is placing restrictions upon the Town to eliminate any residential burning privileges in order for the Town to obtain a burn permit at the central yard waste site.

NOWHEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Almira do hereby ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Ordinance 401 dated 3-10-98 is hereby repealed.

**Section 2.** Residential burning is prohibited all year around.

**Section 3.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

**Section 4.** The ordinance is hereby approved and the Town Clerk is directed to publish the same in the Town's official newspaper pursuant to RCW 35.27.300.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval and five days after its publication.
