

**RESOLUTION NO. 2006 - 124**  
**Rescinding Resolution #2006-121**  
**RE: Formation of Fire District #10-Stehekin**

Re: Special Election to be Held for Formation of Chelan County Fire District # 10

Whereas, the Chelan County Commissioners have received a petition from residents of the Stehekin Area, to form a Fire District pursuant to RCW 52.02; and,

Whereas, on August 8, 2006, the Chelan County Auditor Elections Director duly certified said petition indicating sufficiency; and,

Whereas, in accordance with RCW 52.02.040, a Public Hearing was conducted on September 12, 2006 to consider said petition; and,

Whereas, at said Public Hearing a record was made that the legal description in the petition contained typographical errors of which do not change the legal description and have been corrected; and,

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners considered whether the formation of the proposed district will be conducive to the public health, welfare, and convenience and be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the proposed district; and,

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners further considered the finalization of the boundaries of said proposed district; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Chelan County Commissioners finds that the following legal description, listed as Attachment A, shall establish the definite and final boundary lines for the proposed Chelan County Fire District No. 10 located in Chelan County, Washington,

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER DETERMINED that the Board of County Commissioners finds that establishment of the Chelan County Fire District No. 10 will be conducive to the public health, welfare, and convenience and be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries established herein for the proposed district, and

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that a special mail in ballot election shall be conducted by the Chelan County Auditor within the boundaries of the proposed district on **November 7, 2006**, and the hours during which ballots must be post marked on or before November 7,

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the mail in ballot for said special election shall be in the following form:

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that because the petition to form the Chelan County Fire District No. 10 requested that a proposed multi-year property tax levy assessment shall be \$ .50 per thousand dollars of assessed value, for general expenses of the District, a separate ballot proposition to the voters at the same election shall be in the following form:

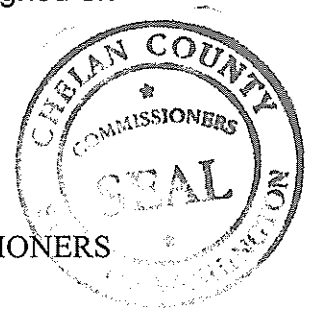

## ATTACHMENT A

BEGINNING AT PLUMMER MT., WHICH IS ABOUT THE NW CORNER OF SEC. 11, T31N, R15E, THENCE NORTH ON THE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN CHELAN AND SNOHOMISH COUNTIES; THENCE FOLLOWING ALONG SAID COUNTY LINE A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION BETWEEN SKAGIT AND CHELAN COUNTIES TO THE OKANOGAN COUNTY LINE; THENCE CONTINUING EASTERLY AND SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE BOUNDARY LINE OF OKANOGAN AND CHELAN COUNTIES TO STAR MT.; WHICH IS ABOUT ¼ MILE EAST OF THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 26, T32N, R19E.; THENCE IN A SOUTHWESTERLY DIRECTION TO THE MAIN SOURCE OF CASCADE CREEK, AND DOWN SAID CREEK IN THE SAME GENERAL DIRECTION TO A POINT IN THE MIDDLE OF LAKE CHELAN OPPOSITE WHERE CASCADE CREEK EMPTIES INTO SAID LAKE; THENCE IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION UP THE MIDDLE OF LAKE CHELAN TO A POINT WHERE THE LINE BETWEEN TOWNSHIPS 31N. AND 32N. R. 18E. CROSSES LAKE CHELAN; THENCE WEST ALONG SAID TOWNSHIP LINE 4 MILES MORE OR LESS TO A POINT WHERE THE TOWNSHIP LINE CROSSES THE DIVIDE BETWEEN RIDDLE CREEK AND RAILROAD CREEK; THENCE N.W. ALONG THE DIVIDE TO RIDDLE PEAKS; THENCE ALONG THE DIVIDE BETWEEN RAILROAD CREEK AND COMPANY CREEK IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION TO MARTIN PEAK; THENCE IN THE SAME GENERAL DIRECTION TO BONANZA PEAK, CONTINUING ALONG THE DIVIDE BETWEEN RAILROAD CREEK AND THE SOUTH FORK OF AGNES CREEK IN A SOUTHWESTERLY DIRECTION TO NORTH STAR MT.; THENCE CONTINUING IN THE SAME GENERAL DIRECTION TO PLUMMER MT., THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
