

RESOLUTION NO. 4 -2002

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEAVENWORTH,
WASHINGTON, REQUESTING INCLUSION IN A
MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT PROPOSED TO THE
CITY COUNCIL BY THE LEAVENWORTH LIONS CLUB**

WHEREAS, the Leavenworth Lions Club has provided mosquito control services in the Leavenworth area for a number of years, funded through donations and administered through the volunteerism of Lions Club members; and

WHEREAS, Leavenworth residents have benefited from these services through a reduction in the nuisance and health hazards associated with mosquitoes; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 17.28 RCW provides for the creation of mosquito control districts by counties of the state of Washington for the purpose of abating the nuisance of mosquitos; and

WHEREAS, the Leavenworth Lions Club has presented a proposal to the Leavenworth City Council requesting that the Chelan County Commissioners form a mosquito control district that would include the city of Leavenworth; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this mosquito control district would be to take over the program started by the Lions Club; and

WHEREAS, Leavenworth residents would be provided with an opportunity to vote on the issue as provided by RCW 17.28.090 if the district is initially approved by County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, RCW 17.28.030 provides that cities may be included in mosquito control districts only through the formal adoption of a resolution requesting that county commissioners include the city in the proposed district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Leavenworth,

The City of Leavenworth formally requests to be included in the formation of a mosquito control district as presented by the Leavenworth Lions Club at a Council studysession on March 5, 2002, as provided under Chapter 17.28 RCW

ADOPTED by the City Council and signed by the Mayor on the 26th day of March, 2002.

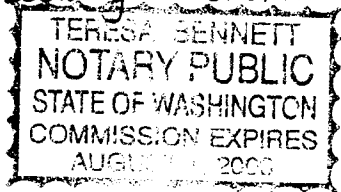
