ORDINANCE #203

An ORDINANCE relating to fireworks; banning the sale and discharge of during the season of July 4,1992.

BE IT ORDAINED BY NESPELEM TOWN COUNCIL:

Drought conditions exist in our town. The land is extremely dry and extreme fire danger exists.

THEREFORE:

The Nespelem Town Council does deem it necessary to ban the sale and the discharge of firecrackers within town limits.

THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF NESPELEM, WA., as follows:

Section 1 The sale of and the discharge of fireworks within the Town of Nespelem is banned entirely.

Section 2 This ORDINANCE shall be in effect until the drought conditions cease in 1992.

Section 3 This ORDINANCE is necessary for the safety from fire of homes and property in Nespelem, WA.

This ORDINANCE shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and posting as provided by law.
