

**RESOLUTION NO. 556**

**A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Woodland, Washington adopting the 2007 Cowlitz County Solid Waste Management Plan.**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 70.95.080 requires each city in the state to prepare a comprehensive solid waste management plan in cooperation with counties and cities within the planning area; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 70.95.110 requires each city to review and revise, if necessary, the comprehensive solid waste management plan at least once each five years; and

**WHEREAS**, the development of such a plan will contribute to the health and safety of all City of Woodland residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the cities within the planning area, pursuant to resolutions of concurrence and in accordance with RCW 39.34, Interlocal Cooperation Act, have by way of an Interlocal Agreement for Management of Solid Waste authorized Cowlitz County to prepare a solid waste management plan on the city's behalf; and

**WHEREAS**, the Solid Waste Division of Cowlitz County's Department of Public Works with the assistance of the Solid Waste Advisory Committee, have prepared the plan; and


**WHEREAS**, the Solid Waste Advisory Committee recommended the plan to be approved by the county and cities within the planning area.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Woodland that the City of Woodland does hereby adopt the 2007 Cowlitz County Solid Waste Management Plan, as recommended by the Solid Waste Advisory Committee for approval on December 12, 2007.


