## NOTICE OF CALL FOR BIDS 2007 Liquid Asphalt

Sealed Bids will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Okanogan County, in their office in the Grainger Administrative Building, 123 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue N Room 150, Okanogan, Washington 98840, until **10:30 a.m., Tuesday, March 27, 2007** at which time they will be opened and publicly read.

### DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The project generally consists of supplying liquid asphalt to Okanogan County Department of Public Works for the 2007 season.

### MATERIALS

Liquid asphalt for 2007 season.

### AWARD

*The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, waive any irregularities or informalities and award the bid as the Board determines to be in Okanogan County's greatest advantage or best interest. The contract will be awarded on the basis of best and lowest bid conforming to the specifications, including awarding individual line items when appropriate. Rebates and delivery date will also be a consideration in awarding the bid.*

### DELIVERY

All prices shown in the proposal shall be F.O.B. Bidders Plant. Delivery of all products shall be coordinated with the County's Road Maintenance Supervisor located at 1234 A Second Avenue S, Okanogan, WA 98840 - Telephone (509) 422-7300.

### PAYMENT

Payment shall be made within thirty (30) days of receipt of the invoice for delivered product.

**OPENING TIME:** March 27, 2007 at 10:30 a.m.

**PLACE:** Okanogan County Commissioner's Office, at the Grainger Administration Building at 123 N. 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Room 150, Okanogan, WA 98840.

**DELIVERY:** As requested or needed for daily operations.

## INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. All bids shall be presented or otherwise delivered to the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners and shall be sealed. Bids shall be clearly labeled in lower left hand corner of envelope:

**"SEALED BID - LIQUID ASPHALT ROAD OIL".**

2. Bids shall be submitted to the Okanogan County Commissioners, 123 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, Room 150, Okanogan, Washington 98840.
3. Bids received by the County may not be withdrawn after the time set in the notice for bid opening. All bids received shall be opened at the time and place set in the notice inviting bids. The bid award will be made within thirty (30) days of the date of the opening of bids, unless complicating circumstances arise.
4. The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to revise quantities to meet budget allocations and to waive formalities which do not affect the essential fairness of the bidding process, and to accept the bid deemed best overall for Okanogan County.
5. Bids must be submitted on the "Bid Submittal Form", which is available from the office of Okanogan County Department of Public Works, 1234-A 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South, Okanogan, Washington 98840.
6. All prices shown in the Bid shall be F.O.B. the bidders' plant.
7. The products supplied must meet requirements set forth in section 9-02 of the 2006 State of Washington Standard Specifications. Samples and temperature readings of the product may be taken from each load in order to determine products meet WSDOT Standard Specifications.
  - a. Minimum temperatures at job site should be Cutback 220°F and Emulsion 160°F.
8. Though an approximate tonnage of asphalt product is provided in this bid package, Okanogan County does not guarantee that it is the exact quantity needed for anticipated operations in the 2007 construction season.
9. The following is applicable to Washington State regulations and Okanogan County hereby notifies all persons submitting quotes, that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this invitation to quote, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit quotes in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin in consideration for an award.
10. The following is applicable to Washington State All Bidders are hereby notified that Okanogan County is an Equal Opportunity Employer that it is a contractual obligation that the successful bidder not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, marital status, or the presence of any physical, sensory or mental disability.
