### PROCUREMENT AND INSTALLATION OF CCTV EQUIPMENT TO SERVE THE CITY OF RENTON'S SKATEBOARD PARK AND COMMUNITY CENTER

You are invited to submit a Proposal for the PROCUREMENT AND INSTALLATION of CCTV equipment to serve the City of Renton Skateboard Park and the Renton Community Center, Renton, Washington. Proposals shall be submitted to the Community Services, 5<sup>th</sup> floor, City Hall, 1055 Grady Way, Renton, WA, 98055 until **2:30 PM Monday, March 18, 2002** and then will be publicly opened and read aloud in Room 521, fifth floor. Proposals received after the specified time and date will not be considered.

The project scope includes the following tasks:

- Install a pan tilt zoom camera for the Liberty Park Skate Park. This camera will be mounted on a designated pole provided by the city. The connection for the camera will require communications via an IP address at the Library. The camera PTZ controls and the digital recorder will reside at the Community Center allowing viewing from that location and will connect to the system via an IP address there.
- Procure all materials and equipment necessary to fulfill the requirements of the project scope.

The single contract bid price includes the appropriate supervision, scheduling, and job site management. The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and waive any informalities or irregularities in the proposals received. No performance bond is required. An approximate estimated cost is \$25,000.

The City's fair practices/non-discrimination policies and State Prevailing Wage Rates apply to this project.

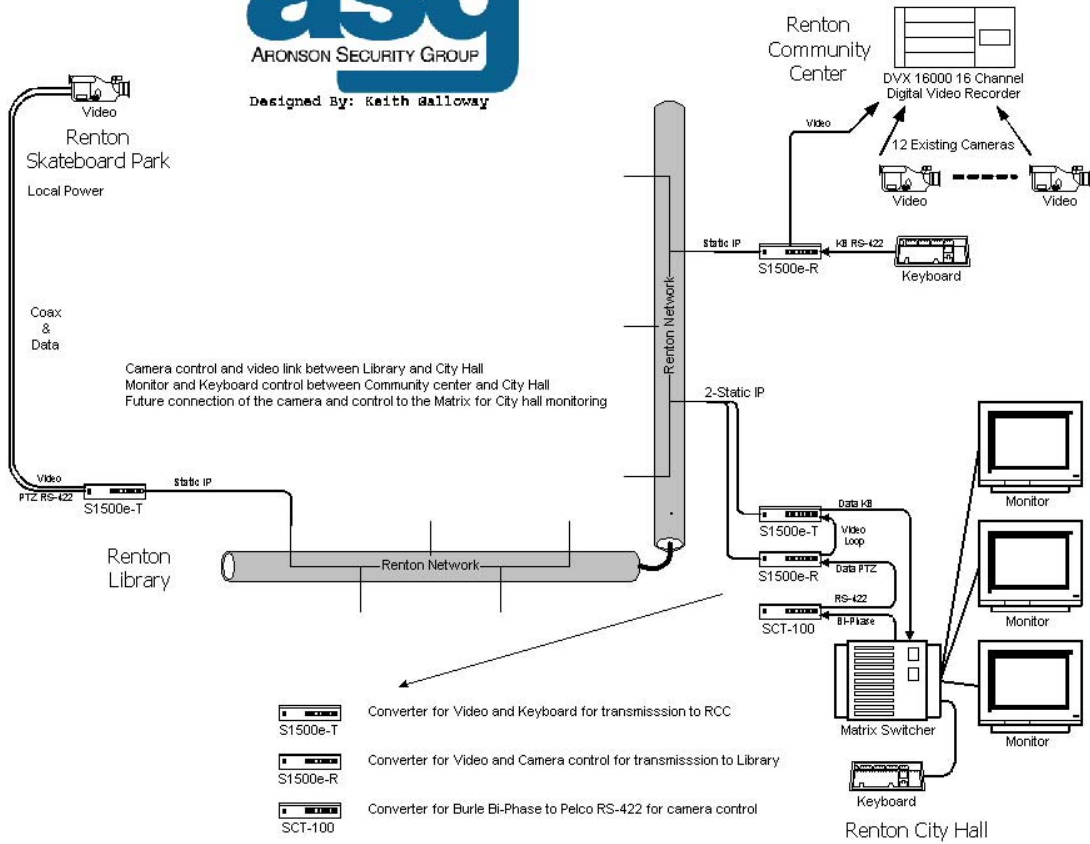
