Motion – Mr. Brock: I move we grant preliminary approval of Short Plat 2003-02 subject to the seven findings of fact and the five conditions of approval. This is Resolution 2003-107. Second by Mrs. Corkrum. 3:0 vote in favor. (Exhibit 16)

Code Enforcement

The Planning Department has received a complaint about having a camel in the Riverview area. The issue is actually how do we deal with camels, emus, ostriches, etc., in our urban residential zone. A public hearing is scheduled in April with the Planning Commission to address the animal definition. After they make a decision, they will forward it to the Board. Mr. MacPherson noted that there are other camels in the same area.

The Board would like to refund the \$700 fee that the camel owner paid. After discussion, the Board asked that the application be a county-sponsored ordinance application in which the county is looking at re-evaluating the animal unit definition for clarification. Mrs. Corkrum asked if we could refer to the State Wildlife agency's dangerous animal list in developing the county's definition. Mr. MacPherson said yes.

Mr. Wendt left the meeting.

 **Mosquito District Election**

Mr. Brock said he has had calls asking about the boundaries of the proposed mosquito control district. He said it is unfortunate that it is unclear on the ballot that it is county-wide.

Mrs. Corkrum has had an inquiry about whether senior citizens could be exempt from the mosquito levy. The Assessor is checking with the Prosecutor's Office for an answer.

Building Report Update

The Building Department has received \$42,881 in fees as of February 21. Mr. MacPherson said we are a lot busier this year than we were last year. There are about 35 permits waiting to be picked up. There are many very large single family homes being built.
