Commissioners' Proceeding for September 4, 2002

Mr. Bowen recommended the J&J Security contract be cut to two days a week instead of five because of budget concerns. The contract is \$48,600, a monthly rate of \$4050. It would cost about \$19,000 for two days a week.

Mr. Brock said we could always increase the coverage later. Mrs. Corkrum said if it is left as it is, the increase is less than \$100 per month. Mr. Bowen recommended having the security two days a week and on high profile cases. There was discussion about the security needs. Mrs. Miller suggested that the court staff be contacted so they would let Mr. Bowen know when a particular trial may need more security.

The Board gave **consensus approval** to have Mr. Bowen do some more research prior to signing a contract.
